Care ministries

Common transitions of life and its difficulties cut across each person's human experience. LCBC's Care Ministries seeks to connect people with resources that enable them to continue moving forward as fully devoted followers of Christ during those times.

Financial ministries

Many people experience financial difficulties at various times, for a variety of reasons. LCBC provides assistance in three areas to people who are regular attenders.

Benevolence

Limited financial assistance is available to those who are regular attenders of the weekend services for at least four months. An application process is followed to assess each individual situation and make decisions about assistance.

CARs Ministry

Reliable vehicles are available to those who are approved through the benevolence process.

Good \$ense

Discover the peace and contentment that comes from managing your financial resources in God-honoring ways, through the budget course that is offered several times a year.

Counseling referrals

LCBC does not offer counseling, but Care Ministries and the Ministry Leadership Team make referrals to approved Christian counselors as needed.

Support & Recovery ministries

These ministries are to help people walk through the challenges that life sometimes brings.

Celebrate Recovery

A biblically-based 12-step program for people in recovery and their family and friends to enable participants to find freedom from hurts, hang-ups and habits.

Deaf Interpretation

Sign language is available at the 9am Sunday service for the deaf and hard of hearing, as well as other services as needed.

Divorce Care

A support group to help individuals as they recover from the hurt of separation and divorce. Tools are provided to help with healing and recovery whatever the outcome of the situation.

GriefShare

A small group for those who have experienced the passing of a loved one to enable them to work through their grief.

Special Needs Ministry

Buddies provide 1:1 support for kids and students with special needs so they can be included in our regular weekend programs while their parents attend the worship gathering. The Access Room provides a safe and supervised place for kids requiring specialized attention. The Overcomers class is a support group/Bible Study for parents of special needs kids.

Response ministries

These ministries are active in event of life's difficulties, whether a crisis or not.

Compassion Team

A team that provides immediate practical support (including a meal following a funeral) for those who have experienced the loss of a loved one.

Hospital Chaplains

A rotation of chaplains makes prompt visits to those in our LCBC family who undergo medical treatment at local hospitals.

Meals

Meals can be provided for people in need due to illness, birth of a baby or other life events.

Prayer Team

A group who prays weekly for requests from the worship services and during the week, as well as a group who prays for the emergency needs of the church and community.

Prison Ministry

Specially selected chaplains visit inmates connected in some way to LCBC people in the local prisons.

Funerals

A LCBC pastor can be available to conduct the funeral service for LCBC attendees.
