Open

- 1. Have you ever been cheated on in a relationship? What was that like?
- 2. Is there a difference between a cheater and someone who made a big mistake?
- 3. Look again at the list of reasons why people cheat. Which of those reasons for cheating do you find most understandable?

Reasons:

- a. Not thinking.
- b. For the rush of passion.
- c. Because of low self-esteem
- d. The relationship wasn't fulfilling anymore.
- e. Craving variety.
- f. Wanting revenge.
- g. Dealing with toxic partners.
- h. Cheating because they fell out of love.

Dig

- 1. Read Hosea 4:1-3; 13-14 again as a group. What does faithlessness lead to?
- 2. Why is marital faithfulness such a big deal to God?
- 3. Do you feel like you will continue to be faithful (or will be faithful if you are not married yet) to your spouse? Why?

Take Further

- 1. What have you done in your life to make sure you practice faithfulness to your spouse both now and in the future?
- 2. Look again at that list of reasons can those be reasons for unfaithfulness to God also?
- 3. Is there a way to start over again if you have been unfaithful? What does that look like?

Prayer

- Spend time praying for strength to remain faithful (or be faithful one day)
- Also spend time praying for wholeness and forgiveness in the wake of infidelity.
