Share high fives.

Ask: What was your favorite song from this past year?



Open the Bible as a family. If possible, give each family member their own Bible.

Say: The Bible is a collection of 66 books of history, stories, letters, and poetry, that fit together to form God's one big story. The epic adventure of how he created us, loves us so much, and made a way to rescue us.

Read: Ephesians 5:19-20

Review:

- Ephesians was written by a man named Paul. Paul met Jesus after Jesus died. Paul did not like Jesus or people who believed in him and then his whole life changed when he met a resurrected Jesus! Paul's life after meeting Jesus was all about convincing people that Jesus came to save the world!
- What song would best represent someone who saved the world?



Let's keep things spicy and upbeat by bringing a twist to taco night by making Taco Pinwheels.

First, make the filling by mixing taco meat, cream cheese, shredded cheese, and salsa. There are no exact ratios for this mix, you can make it to your family's preference!

Next, spread the filling to cover a tortilla. Sprinkle lettuce on top. Roll up tightly. Wrap tortilla in plastic wrap and refrigerate for at least one hour.

Finally, unwrap and cut into one-inch slices. Serve pinwheels with optional salsa, guacamole, or sour cream on the side.

Worship music is impactful to our lives because it helps connect our hearts to God in a deep and personal way. It creates space for God's presence to move in us, unites us as families and communities, and helps us refocus on what truly matters.

Over the next year, your challenge is to take turns selecting a worship song for the week. Each week, listen to the song selected by a family member together, and share what lyrics stuck out to you, why you think it is meaningful, or how it connects God to what you are going through. Then, add this song to a family worship playlist on YouTube, Spotify, or Apple Music. Keep this playlist at the forefront of family moments like road trips, pulling weeds, cleaning the house, or picnics!



Ask:

- What songs make you feel the happiest?
- What music reminds you of certain memories or places in your life?
- Do you think listening to or making music is a good way to express emotions? Why or why not



Worshiping God is one of the best ways we can grow in our faith. It reveals, and strengthens, our understanding of God's grace for us. Encourage your child to connect with God by playing worship music while doing homework, drawing, and playing. Ask them to reflect on what they think and feel when hearing certain lyrics.
